Regulation

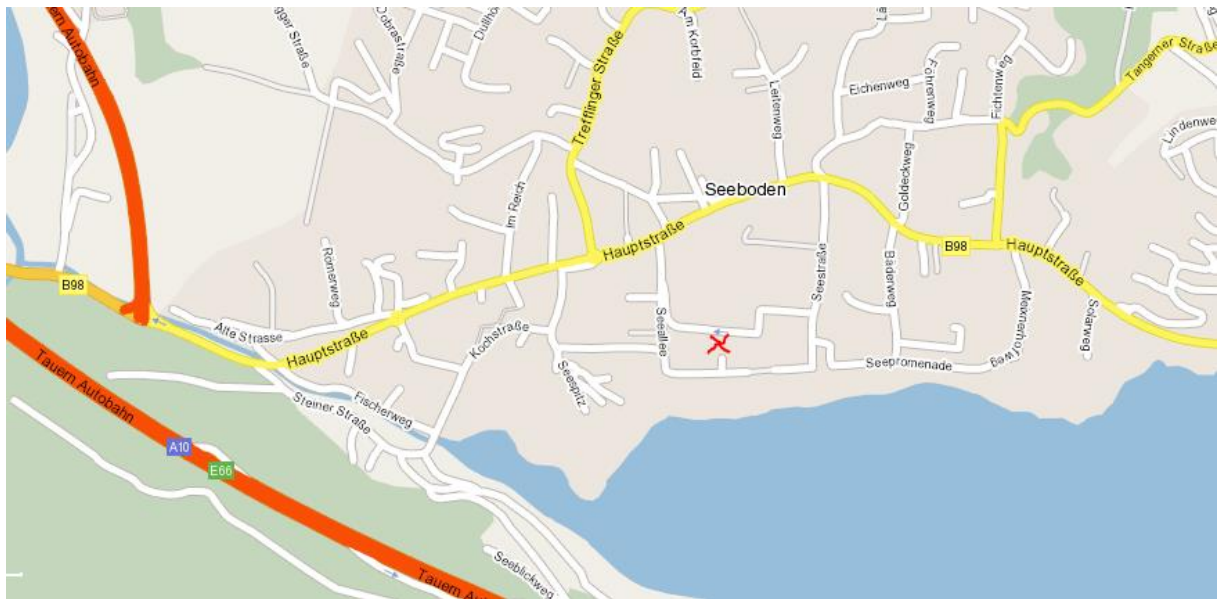
The contest rules of Austrian Aero Club (section hang and paragliding) will be applied.

Rules for Participation

Pilot license, FAI sport license, checked paraglider (EN A-D, CCC), valid third-party and rescue insurance, helmet, safety parachute and back protector, paid entry fee, completed and signed registration form

Race Office

Restaurant and Bar „Habe d´ Ehre“, located at Seepromenade, 9871 Seeboden am Millstätter See



Registration and Fee

Pilots must register at <http://www.livetrack24.com/events> or on first competition day in race office.

€ 55.- for participants of Alpe-Adria-Cup

€ 30.- for participants of Carinthian championship and „New Comer“ (Austrian PG league)

If a task is cancelled one day in advance, 20.- € (resp. 10.- € for new comer and participants of Carinthian championship) will be refunded.

Registration fee must be paid in cash during registration and includes competition fee, transport to take off and pickup service, and ranking.

Tasks

2 tasks depending on weather (e. g. race to goal, speed run). Ranking will be valid even if only one task can be performed.

Program

1st day – 30th of June

7.15 a. m.	Registration
9.30 a. m.	Official welcome of participants on landing area, pilots' briefing, departure to take-off
11 a. m.	Briefing and sign-in at take-off and first task
From 3 p. m.	unofficial meeting of pilots on landing area and party

2nd day – 1st of July

9.30 a. m.	Pilots' briefing, departure to take off
11 a. m.	Briefing and sign-in at take-off and second task
From 3 p. m.	Unofficial meeting of pilots on landing area
Appr. 5 p. m.	Award ceremony

Decision about execution

On 29th of June noon, it will be finally decided if the competition will be executed. Decision will be posted on www.dgfc.at and www.paragleiter.org.

Documentation

Flight documentation only with pilot's GPS. Organizer will provide well-established data cables (e. g. from Garmin or Bräuniger). Other cables must be provided by pilots themselves.

- Alpe-Adria-Cup Fun & Safety class (EN A-B)

Awards

Prize money of 300.- € for the winners of Open class (EN A-D, CCC) & also 300.- € for the winners of the Fun & Safety class (EN A-B)

Protest

Free formal objection latest within 30 minutes after posting of provisional ranking.

Official protests only in writing within 30 minutes after posting of final ranking submitted to organizer. Protest fee € 36,-

Protest fee to highest federal flight commission ONF € 73,-

Each pilot participates at own risk and is responsible to comply with Austrian law. Pilots must not make organizer nor any third-party accountable for accidents, injuries or any other incidents.
